Pre-doctoral Level Internship Opportunities

Pennsylvania Counseling Services offers a full-time APPIC accredited 12 month Pre-doctoral Internship in Clinical Psychology. The primary method of training is experiential and includes exposure to a wide variety of clientele from diverse ethnic and socioeconomic backgrounds. This broad-based training experience is composed of three distinctly different 12-month tracks; Family-Based, Crossroads: Drug & Alcohol/Dual Diagnosis (Inpatient, Partial Hospitalization, and Intensive Outpatient), & Multisystemic Therapy (MST). Minor elective rotations consist of various outpatient opportunities (mental health, EAP, D&A, sex-offender groups, etc.) in our satellite offices in south central Pennsylvania. Duties of the intern will include using psychotherapeutic interventions in both individual and group settings. This is a paid internship with opportunity for bonus pay, paid single coverage health insurance, and paid time off benefits (vacation, holidays and dissertation release time).

Bachelor's Level Internship Opportunities

Pennsylvania Counseling Services offers internship/practicum experiences to students enrolled in a Bachelor's Degree human services program (such as psychology, social work, addiction studies). PCS offers a semester-long, 200 hour experience-based internship. Participants will have three rotations from which to choose: Children's Services Community Based Treatment, Summer Therapeutic Activities Program, or Drug & Alcohol Outpatient Treatment. Please note: this is a non-paid internship.

Children's Services Community Based Internship Rotation:

This rotation will include 200 hours of treatment observation in a community based setting such as the child's home, school, or other community facility as well as participation in clinical group supervision where treatment strategies and children's mental health concepts are discussed. Participants will also gain independent experience by providing Respite Care to clients in their homes, and in summer day camp settings.

Summer Therapeutic Activities Program Internship Rotation:

This rotation will include 200 hours of treatment observation and active participation in a summer camp environment. Participants of this rotation will be expected to play an active role in direct client care.

Drug & Alcohol Outpatient Services Internship Rotation:

This rotation will include 200 hours of treatment observation and active participation in both individual and group therapy. Participants of this rotation will be expected to play an active role in direct client care.

Master's Level Internship Opportunities

Pennsylvania Counseling Services offers internship/practicum experiences to students enrolled in a Master's degree human services program (such as psychology, social work, counseling). This is a part-time mental health outpatient internship. PCS requires that interns provide approximately 16 hours of on-site service to the clinic. Of the 16 hours, it is expected that 13 will be direct clinical care to publicly funded clients. PCS will provide weekly individual supervision throughout the internship experience. Internship/practicum experiences must cover a minimum of two consecutive school semesters. Please note: this is a non-paid internship.
